Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by Francis and Cathleen Kavanaugh to maintain an existing pile supported residence at 12 Park View Avenue in the municipality of Beverly in and over Flowed Tidelands of the Danvers River. No new activity or change in use is being considered as part of this application. The proposed project has been determined to be nonwater-dependent. The project will also require a variance from one or more provisions of the Waterways Regulations.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Thursday, June 29, 2006, at 11:00 AM at the Beverly Public Library, 32 Essex Street, Beverly. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by July 20, 2006 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
