## NOTICE OF A REMEDY IMPLEMENTATION PLAN ADDENDUM 3

## HOLYOKE GAS TAR DEPOSITS - SITE PORTIONS 1 and 2 CONNECTICUT RIVER RELEASE TRACKING NUMBER 1-1055

A Remedy Implementation Plan Addendum 3 has been developed for this site pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.0874). This site was classified Tier I on October 1, 1993 and response actions approved by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection - Bureau of Waste Site Cleanup have been conducted since that date. This Addendum has been prepared as required by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection - Bureau of Waste Site Cleanup in its Amendment to Phase IV Approval Conditions for SP-1 and SP-2, dated June 3, 2004. The Addendum was submitted to the DEP on June 2, 2005.

The **Remedy Implementation Plan Addendum 3** includes the following submittals in support of the Remedy Implementation Plan to respond to a release of oil and/or hazardous materials at this site:

- Updated list of key contacts for the project
- Summary of changes
- Contractor's Project Work Plan
- Construction Schedule and Progress Meeting Schedule
- Temporary Cofferdam Plan, Stability Contingency Plan, Dewatering Plan and Overtopping Contingency Plan
- Temporary Tailgate Closure and Outfall Bypass Pumping Plan
- Surface Water Discharge Sampling and Monitoring plan

M.G.L. c. 21E and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan provide additional opportunities for public notice of and involvement in decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: 1) The Chief Municipal Official and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located will be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and 2) Upon receipt of a petition from ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or of a municipality potentially affected by a disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response actions at the site will be prepared and implemented, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1405.
