Public notice is hereby given of the waterways application by the Friends of Ellisville Marsh, Inc., to perform maintenance dredging at the historic entrance channel to Ellisville Harbor and utilize dredge material for beach/dune nourishment, off Ellisville Road, in the municipality of Plymouth and within the Ellisville Harbor ACEC, in and over flowed tidelands of Cape Cod Bay and Ellisville Harbor. The proposed project has been determined to be water-dependent.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received within 15 days subsequent to the "Notification Date". Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
