

“The Lancaster Water Department has applied to DEP for a Request for Site Exam application for siting or expanding a public water supply source to withdraw up to approximately 0.77 mgd of water from the ground water of the Nashua River Basin, in Lancaster, Massachusetts. The location(s) of the withdrawal point(s) is in Lancaster, approximately 250 feet to the west adjacent to the Bolton town line, off of Rt. 110 and Forbush Mill Road, and across the street from the southern entrance to the Bolton Flats conservation area.

Written comments on the granting of a DEP permit to conduct additional testing of the site for a new or expanded water supply withdrawal are to be filed within thirty (30) days of publication of this notice in the Environmental Monitor. The written comments are to be submitted to the Drinking Water Program Section Chief at the DEP Central Regional Office, 627 Main Street, Worcester, MA 01608.”
