

A.D. Makepeace Corporation has applied to DEP for a Request for Site Exam application for siting a public water supply source to withdraw up to approximately 300,000 mgd of water from the ground or surface water of the Buzzards Bay River Basin, in Plymouth, MA. The original site was presented in the Expanded Environmental Notification Form (EENF) submitted on July 30, 2005 by VHB of Watertown, MA (see MEPA #13580, Wareham Road Mixed Use Development Project) existing northeast of Fawn Pond.

This site has been relocated just west of Agawam Reservoir, off of Agawam Road in Plymouth, MA. The original proposed site at 41° 49'55.55" North, 070° 37' 52.46" West has been moved to the new location at 41° 48'56.58" North, 070° 38'31.56" West.

Written comments on the granting of a DEP permit to conduct additional testing of the site for a new or expanded water supply withdrawal are to be filed within thirty (30) days of publication of this notice in the Environmental Monitor. The written comments are to be submitted to the Drinking Water Program Section Chief at the DEP Southeast Regional Office, 20 Riverside Drive, Lakeville MA 02347.
