Public notice is hereby given of the Waterways application by Bufftree Building Company to construct and maintain a 30 unit condominium complex (2 buildings containing 12 units & 2 buildings containing 6 units) and associated amenities, and public benefit elements including, a commercial facility for public accommodation, public walkways and parking, and creation of a "pocket park" in conjunction with other improvements to Pease Park in the municipality of Fairhaven on Filled Tidelands of the Acushnet River. The proposed project has been determined to be nonwater-dependent.

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waterways Regulation Program, will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid project proposal on Thursday, December 14, 2006, at 10:00 am in the Millicent Library Auditorium (use Walnut Street entrance) at 45 Center Street, Fairhaven, MA. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a Waterways License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Waterways application received by January 5, 2007 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c).
